

District Level Trainings

- Objectives** :
- To identify the problems that involve legal questions and to develop a creative mind to contemplate problems that may arise and to find out probable solutions for such problems.
 - To modify, regulate and streamline, the attitude and behaviour of the judicial officers in the subordinate judiciary; not only to make their mind attuned to resolution of complicated problems, but also to understand men and matters that come up before them in the course of administration of Justice.

Nature of training : The academy conducts one day District Level Programme for the judicial officers of each district at the District centres. For the District Level Trainings, the academy requests the officers to send up legal problems on any provision of Law, in the form of questions, and the questions received are made into a questionnaire. It would be sent back to the Judicial Officers in advance so that they would be able to make intensive study of the legal problems raised and get them involved in the discussion. The questionnaire covers a wide range of subjects of law and matters of practical importance. This problem based training helps analyzing the deductive reasoning of each officer. The Hon'ble Judges constituting the Governing Body and the Honourable Judges in charge of the Judicial Administration of the districts are actively participating in the District Level Training Programmes.

The Academy has so far conducted 125 District Level Trainings for the judicial officers at the District Centres involving all the 14 districts from 1992 onwards.
